

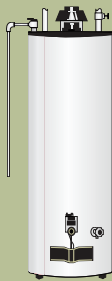
Less Energy



According to the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) tankless water heaters with an .82 Energy Factor are expected to save a consumer approximately \$108 in annual energy costs compared to a typical gas storage water heater. Energy Factor is a measurement of relative energy efficiency for a water heater; the higher the Energy Factor, the more energy efficient the water heater.

Reduce Global Warming



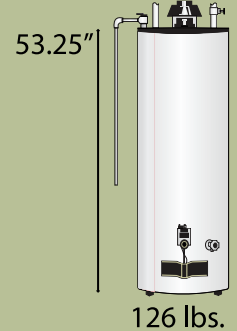
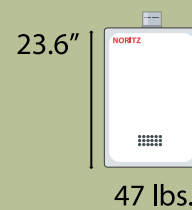
In five years, the DOE states that Americans can save \$780 million in utility costs, avoid 4.2 million tons of carbon dioxide emissions and achieve cumulative energy savings of more than 3.9 billion kilowatt-hours and 270 million therms natural gas by using high efficiency water heaters.

Global Warming



With the ever growing concern over the threat of Global Warming, the time to take action is now. Polar Bears



Polar bears are drowning. A drastic climate change in the Arctic due to Global Warming is accelerating the melting of the ice. Scientists, for the first time, have documented multiple deaths of polar bears off Alaska, where they likely drowned after swimming long distances in the ocean amid the melting of the Arctic ice shelf. Some scientists predict polar bears could become extinct within the next century because they have adapted over the millennia to only hunting on ice. If they try to swim in disappearing ice conditions to catch seals, more are likely to tire and drown, scientists say.
